LYDIA JOHNSON DANCE. Ms. Johnson is a tantalizingly distinctive modern-dance choreographer who does things like making dances from flowing phrases of awkward movement and slight discordancies. The program includes two new pieces, set to music by Gorecki and Bach, and recent dances that include "The Right Allocations," a piece for adult women and teenaged boys that is set to pop music by Cake, Moby and Aimee Mann, and "Langsam in Der Sorge," set to Hindemith.
